

KGC Members' Tariff 2021

Tariff valid from 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022.

Annual fees unless otherwise stated.

Membership fees

Full Flying Member Over 18 years (inc. BGA Capitation fee of £35) £500.00
(for 2021/22 members who sign up for the direct debit plan, or pay in full before 1 April 2022, will pay £480- 8 instalments of £60)

Trial Member Full flying membership for a period of 1 Calendar month following, completion of a flight purchased via the following courses:

Day course - £250; Half Day course -£150; Trial Lesson -£100; Week Course -£650.

Trial members are entitled to a £75 discount on full membership (day course and week only) or a £35 discount (Trial lesson and Half Day Course). Club membership year runs from 1st April to March 31st.

Go for solo course Includes one year's membership, with up to 15 aerotows & 40 winch launches - £1,450
(Go for solo course must be paid in full up front. Following review after 3 months, if a pupil decides not to continue the Club can at its discretion refund the fee less the cost of membership and flights taken at club rates)

Family Member One flying member plus 1 additional adult and up to 3 children £750.00

Junior Member Up to 18 years £70.00

18 to 25 years £140.00

Student in full time education or equivalent (up to age 25) £70.00

Life Member Over 18 years, one single payment £10,000

Reciprocal Member For BGA clubs that charge KGC members £10.00per day

Social Member Full use of Club facilities one dual flight per month at club rates £90.00

Affordable Membership Full participation in club, with one dual winch launch per week, that cannot be carried forward. (subject to Committee approval) £520

Day course fees for Full, Junior & Trial Members

Day course (trial membership must be activated by purchase of an initial Trial Membership product above). £50.00
 The fee once booked is non-refundable or non-transferable, except in the event of bad weather. All launch fees and soaring fees are charged at club rates or deducted from Go for Solo entitlement.

The fee is to base, maintain and operate one aircraft at Challock for more than 1 month, fee will not be refunded for removal of aircraft part way through the year, unless the week/day rate is paid instead.

A non-flying glider based for all or part of the year on site, attracts a charge of £240. In addition, all part owners must pay at least social membership.

Notes:

- Flying fees are due on the day, only Full and Family Members may have a flying account and sums are due on the 1st of the following month, a finance charge will be levied on monthly accounts overdue at the 26th of the month of issue at the rate of 5.00% per month*
- Membership, facility and hangarage fees are due on the 1st April and will be subject to a 20% uplift for non-payment by 16th May. Caravan fees are due on 1st March and 1st November and will be subject to a 20% uplift for non-payment by 16th April and 16th December respectively.*
- Membership fees are to be paid in advance, or by direct debit arrangement of £60 for deduction in May for next 8 months along with flying fees due in that month.*
- For new members, membership after September is charged at 50% of subscription rates*
- Life members must pay the annual BGA affiliation fee (£35) if they fly solo during the year.*
- Full flying members may have up to 3 Friends & Family flights at club rates per year, subject to the payment of a £6 per day membership fee for each individual*
- An annual fee of £100 absolves a member from liability to pay 50% of the excess in the event of damaging club aircraft.*
